A- Good airway assessment Puts on 15 LNRB	2
B- Good B assessment SPo2, RR, Work of Breathing, Low Sats, cyanosis	2
C- CRT HS – gallop or murmur Femoral pulses HE	2
D- AVPU/GCS Blood Sugar	2
E- Hepatomegaly	2
Brief History from mum Poor feeding NVD, no complications SOB Cyanosis	2
Explains concern about diagnosis	2
Calls for Help – anaesthetics, paediatrics, cardiology, PICU	2
If O2 making no difference considers removing it	2
Checks Sats in Right hand (pre-ductal) and feet	2
Asks for Prostin - 20 nanograms/kg/min - Prepares for apnoeas	2
Is cautious with any fluid prescription	1
