



Field Block for the Ear

Criteria

Introduces Self, Confirms patient identify, Washes hands	2, 1
Checks comfort level of patient and gains consent for procedure	2, 1
Checks equipment Iodine Needle and syringe Local anaesthetic Dose 3mg/kg Lidocaine Dose 2mg/kg Bupivacaine	2

 <p>Demonstrates Anatomy</p> <p>Top part of ear – auriculotemporal nerve – (mandibular V3) Block by injecting behind superficial temporal artery</p> <p>Middle ear – lesser occipital nerve (C2)</p> <p>Bottom part of ear – Great auricular nerve (C2C3). Block by injecting line of local anaesthetic behind the ear.</p> <p>Middle bit – auricular branch of vagus nerve (CNX) inject into the tragus when it is everted.</p> <p>OR USE A FIELD/RING BLOCK TECHNIQUE</p> 	<p>2</p> <p>2</p> <p>2</p> <p>2</p> <p>2</p>
