### Criteria

Introduces Self, confirms patient identify, Washes hands,	2, 1
Offers analgesia, ensures comfort of patient	2
Offers chaperone	
Patient exposed neck up.	
Inspects For deformity, erythema, wounds, scars Asymmetry and flattening of cheek Nasal deviation CSF rhinorrhea, otorrhoea Subconjunctival haemorrhage	
Palpates Superior orbital margins Feeling for pain crepits, steps and abnormal movements Subcutaneous emphysema	
Sensation Side of nose and upper lip (infra orbital nerve) Numbness of upper teeth Numbness of lower teeth and lip (infradental nerve – mandibular #).	
Mouth Bleeding, malocclusion, loose teeth	
Eye VA, ROM, Fundi	
Ears Checks for battles sign, inspects ears, performs otoscopy.
