Washed hands	
Confirms identity of doctor	
Listens to junior doctor	
Case 1 – well asthmatic	
<ul> <li>Asks about observation</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Asks about Peak flow</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Ask about treatment received including</li> </ul>	
steroids	
Asks to check inhaler technique	
Case 2 – bilateral renal pain in 70 year old left in	
waiting room	
Shows concern that this may be AAA	
<ul> <li>Asks about observations</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Suggest move patient to resus</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Suggests senior doctor needs to review</li> </ul>	
patient ASAP	
Suggests needs AAA ultrasounds scan	
Case 3 – 3 year old with non-blanching rash	
<ul> <li>Asks about observations</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Asks about distribution of rash</li> </ul>	
States a senior doctor should review as	
concern regarding meningitis	
Case 4 – 16 year old – eaten humous and now is	
making loud sounds –	
Expresses concern regarding airway	
compromise	
Asks about treatment given	
Asks for patient to be moved to resus	
Explains that adrenalin must be given IM	
States to move to resus	
Asks if doctor has any questions	
Suggests reading material particularly on	
anaphylaxis	
Delicately avoids completing CBD – as doctor	
only just started in ED	
Asks about who supervisor is Thanks doctor
