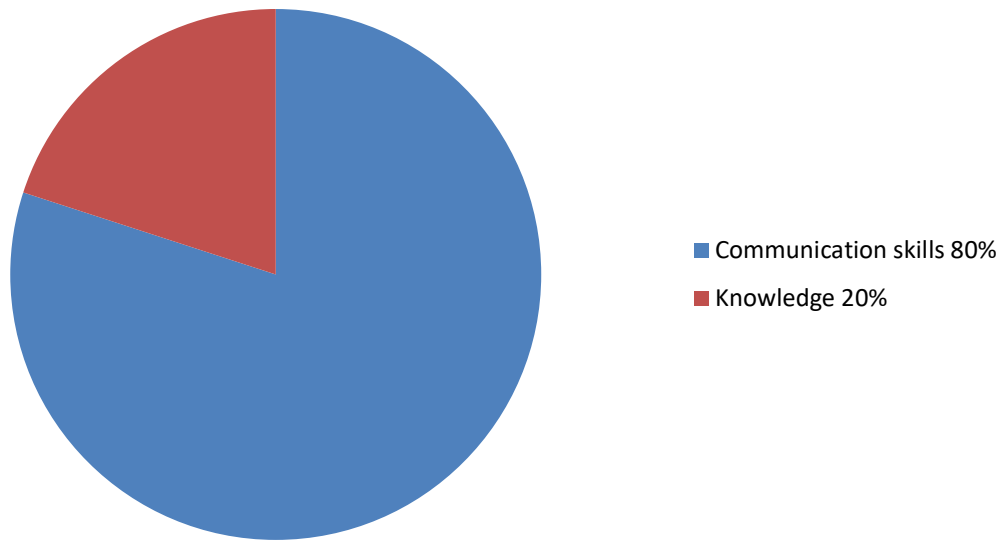


Marking



A 14 year old presents having taken an overdose of 25 paracetamol/ she has had her blood taken and her paracetamol levels are high enough to warrant treatment. She is now refusing treatment. Assess her capacity to refuse treatment

Washed hands	
Introduces self	
Checked identity of patient	
Verbal consent	
Tries to get patient to involve parents	
Checked details of overdose <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Timing • Amount • Any other substances • Intention • Suicidal ideation • Whether patient got help themselves 	
Brief check PMHx DHx Allergies SHx <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smoking • Alcohol • Elicit substances 	
Inform patient about what could happen without treatment	
Check patient understands what treatment will involve	
Checks patient belief of facts	
Checks retention of information	
Able to weigh up information and come to decision	
Again tries to involve parents	
Identify problem with dad	
Identifies that she is worried about being pregnant	
Addresses pregnancy issues – offers test	
Persuades patient to have Rx	
Happy for her to contact mum only	
Thanks patient for her trust	
Patient global score
