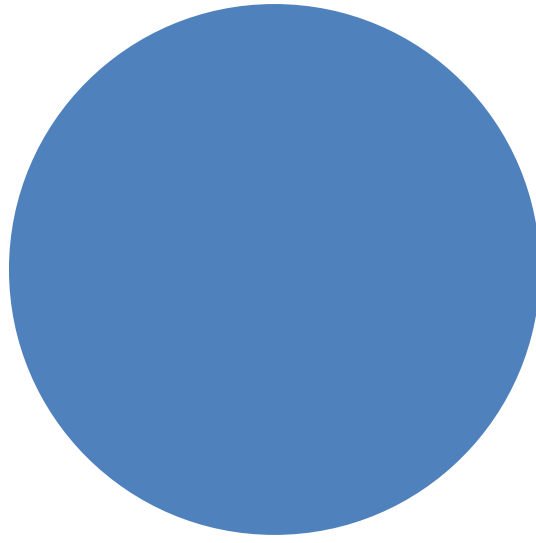

Perform Abdominal examination

Washed hands	
Introduces self	
Checks patient identity	
Obtains verbal consent for examination	
Ask if patient requires any pain relief prior to starting	
Offers to help undress patient	
Inspection from end of bed	
Hand inspection <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clubbing (cirrhosis, IBD, malignancy, malabsorption) • Koilonychia – iron def • Leukonychia – hypoalbuminaemia • Palmar erythema • Dupuytren's contracture 	
Face – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conjunctival pallor • Mucosal ulceration • Tongue for signs of central cyanosis 	
Neck <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lymphadenopathy – Virchow's node 	
Abdomen <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Light and then deep palpation • Palpates for liver • Palpates for spleen • Performs ballotting of kidney 	
Correct use of percussion	
Correct use of auscultation	
Comment on examination of hernia orifice, rectal, external genitalia examination	
Offer to assist the patient redressing	
Tell the examiner that you would like a urinalysis	
Thanks patient	
Asks if patient has any questions	
Correctly summarises	
Patient mark
