Criteria

Introduce Self, Confirms identify of officer	2, 1
Listens to officer's request without interrupting	2,1
Is non-confrontational if officer is obnoxious or aggressive	2,1
Ascertains if reasons for information disclosure fall under any of the following pieces of legislation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Terrorism Acts 2000 • Road Traffic Act 1988 (name and address only) • Court Order That means disclosure is mandatory	2,1
Ascertains if reasons for information disclosure fall under any of the following acts which mean they MAY disclose information <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Police and Criminal Evidence Act 1984 (if someone is may be seriously harmed, murder, rape, kidnap, death by driving) • Child Protection 	2,1
If police officer requests information under section 29(3) of the data protection act, asks to see documentation signed by a police inspector.	2,1
Explains reasons for disclosing information or not	2,1
Offers potential solutions – getting a court order, asking the patient's permission, formally requesting medical notes during the day	2,1
