### Criteria

Introduce Self, Confirms patient identify, Washes hands	2, 1
Checks comfort level of patient and gains consent for examination	2, 1
Undresses patient appropriately (45 degrees, top off)	1
Comments on general appearance, - pallor, SOB, cachexia, scars Breathing pattern – knusmaul, abdominal/paradoxical	2,1
Examines both hands for clubbing, pulmonary oestopathy, cyanosis, nicotine staining, CO2 retention flap	1
Examines face for horners syndrome (ipsilateral ptosis, miosis, enophthalmosis), tongue.	2
Examines JVP	1
Checks lymph nodes	1
Inspects Thorax – size/shape/scars Work of breathing	2
Palpates trachea	1
Palpates chest expansion, checks for S/c emphysema	2
Percusses Axillae, front and back	2
Auscultates front (inc apices), axillae, and back	2
Vocal fremitus and tactile vocal fremitus	1
Signs of cor pulmonale	
Asks for appropriate further Ix , BP, SPO2, ABG, CXR, Sputum	1
