Criteria

Introduces Self, confirms patient identify, Washes hands,	2, 1
Offers analgesia, ensures comfort of patient	2
Confirms nature of the problem	1
Elicits features about the event Timing Weakness Slurred speech Dizziness, vertigo, Nausea, vomit Headache Visual symptoms (amaurosis fugax, hemianopia)	2
Focused PMH Hypertension DM AF Previous TIA/CVA Medications Anticoagulants Allergies	2
Social Hx Smoking Alcohol ADL	2
ROSIER score -1 LOC or Seizure(each) +1 Facial, Leg, Arm weakness, speech disturbance, visual field defect (each)	2
ABCD2 +1 Age > 60, BP >140/90, Speech only, 10-60mins, DM +2 Unilateral weakness, 60+mins (0-3 low risk), (3-5 med risk), (6+ high risk)	2
Management Aspirin/Clopidogrel Statin BP control TIA clinic Inform DVLA (usually have to stop for one month)	2
Explains management plan to patient	2
